Steve called the meeting to order at 5:30PM and introduced those present. Jerry read the ground rules for the meeting.

Jerry made a motion to accept the minutes of 5/5 meeting, seconded by Rick and passed on a voice vote.

Appearances by local citizens/visitors – Brian Hardy was here to address concerns he has with plowing by his house on the Corner of Vance Hill Road and Lake Road. Brian feels that the dirt on his lawn is excessive. He also expressed his concern with the consolidated communication equipment directly across from Vance Hill. He stated that there have been numerous accidents there. Mike Baraw stated that at some point in the past he did invite the Agency of Transportation to this location to discuss this. The board thanked Brian for bringing his concerns before the board.

Rural Edge was here to discuss a potential project in the Village, which are two properties currently owned by Creative Real Estate. They are looking to take ownership by the end of 2022. They gave a presentation of what their plans are with these two buildings. Steve made a motion to work with Rural Edge on 4116 and 4127 VT Route 105 properties, seconded by Rick and passed on a voice vote.

The board discussed the four wheeler club's request to open portions of Searles Road, Cross Road, Niles Road to a VASA trail. Denise stated that the club sent out letters to all property owners on these sections of roads, certified mail return receipt requested, asking for feedback in this regard. The responses received back had one citizen against this. Steve made a motion to open requested sections of Searles Road, Cross Road, Niles Road to VASA, seconded by Jerry and passed on a voice vote.

Road Commissioner Report – Mike stated he has been grading and changing a number of culverts. Mike mentioned working with Mr. Holden who lives at 18 School Street on the culvert which is on School Street. Mike would like to place a DI in the town's right of way which is on 18 School Street property. The board approved Mike moving forward with this project. Mike stated the new pick up has come in and he has put the old pick up for sale. The board authorized Mike to use his discretion with a fair offer for this pick up. Our 10 wheeler is also in. Mike stated that most of our 2022 paving has been completed.

Water/Sewer/Solar Panel report – Mike stated he is still waiting on Manosh and Jeff Hofer to do pump tests on our wells. Mike explained a few minor issues he is taking care of. Mike stated that we are still waiting on our annual sewer inspection.

Rick reviewed the sheriff's report. Some discussion followed.

Steve made a motion to sign the orders and approve the journal entries and bank statement, seconded by Jerry and passed on a voice vote.

Unfinished/new business – there was none.
