Rick called the meeting to order and introduced those present. Jerry read the ground rules for the meeting.

Steve made a motion to approve the minutes of 10/6 and 10/24 meetings, seconded by Jerry and passed on a voice vote.

Appearances by local citizens/visitors – none

Road Commissioner Report – Mike stated that the Farrar Road culvert project has been completed. The grant re-imbusement was finalized and signed by the board. Mike gave the board an update of what the crew has completed this past month. Mike mentioned the possibility of purchasing a sander for the town pick-up. The board stated that this is Mike's decision.

Water/Sewer/Solar panel/Recycling center reports – Mike reported on the water/sewer. Steve gave an update on the recycling center.

Barry Sahagian – was not present.

Rick reviewed the sheriff's report.

Steve made a motion to approve the orders, bank statement and journal entries, seconded by Jerry and passed on a voice vote.

The board signed Desrochers and Daigle cemetery deeds. Steve made a motion to take the 2022 funds that were voted for the watershed and place this in a reserve fund to be used in 2023, seconded by Rick. Some discussion followed. This passed on a voice vote.
